

Beer residuals and food scraps - Opportunities for Vermont Breweries to manage these waste streams

[Agri-Cycle](#) is the Northeast's premier food waste collection service, providing collection of liquid and solid wastes, turning them into beneficial uses, including throughout Vermont.

Agri-Cycle operates a [fleet of trucks](#) dedicated to both solid and liquid food waste collection which accepts all types of [food waste](#) including produce, meat, seafood, and dairy, as well as brewery and other industrial food waste.

Opportunities for Vermont Brewers and options to explore:

Many of Vermont's breweries are small and don't generate large volumes of residuals. Small breweries can dispose of their residuals through their local wastewater treatment plants as economic options don't exist to recycle.

Agri-Cycle sees an opportunity to work with breweries that are located near each other to make hauling brewery residuals more efficient, environmental, and economic. Brewery waste would be recycled in Vermont to create renewable energy, a green marketing opportunity for your brewery, and in line with your Vermont Brewery Association's Sustainability Committee goals.
